

“One Another” Verses in Scripture

Small groups in our church give us the opportunity to live out our faith with one another and out in the world. And living out this type of true biblical community transforms our lives more into the image of Jesus Christ. Thankfully, God’s word gives us many pictures of what this type of transformational community looks like. They are pictures of God’s church being the true body of Christ.

Prayerfully read through these “one another” verses on your own and as a small group this week. Then, be prepared to share what living these verses out looks like practically in the life of our church (and how they may be specifically lived out through small groups). Finally, pray together that God will empower us through His Spirit to live these out.

1. **John 13:34** - "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another." (How Christ continues to love us)
2. **John 13:35** - "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." (How Christ continues to proclaim His relationship with us to the world)
3. **Romans 12:16** - "Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation." (How Christ continues to reach out to the oppressed)
4. **Romans 14:19** - "So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another." (How Christ continues to build us up)
5. **Romans 15:7** - "Therefore, accept one another, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God." (How Christ continues to accept people)
6. **Galatians 5:13** - "For you were called to freedom, brethren; only do not turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another." (How Christ continues to serve us)
7. **Galatians 6:2** - "Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ." (How Christ continues to take on that which we cannot carry)
8. **Ephesians 4:25** - Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE of you WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another. (How Christ continues to confront us with truth we are ignoring)
9. **Ephesians 4:32** - "Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you." (How Christ continues to be kind to us and display forgiveness toward us)
10. **Ephesians 5:21** - "and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ." (How Christ continues to exercise authority over us)
11. **1 Thessalonians 4:18** - "Therefore comfort one another with these words." (How Christ continues to comfort us)
12. **1 Thessalonians 5:15** - "See that no one repays another with evil for evil, but always seek after that which is good for one another and for all people." (How Christ continues to overlook evil and unconditionally do what is best for others)
13. **Hebrews 3:13** - "But encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called "Today," so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin." (How Christ continues to encourage us)
14. **Hebrews 10:24** - "and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds," (How Christ continues to motivate us to do what is honoring to Him)
15. **James 5:16** - "Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much." (How Christ continues to hear our confession and He petitions for us)
16. **1 Peter 4:9** - "Be hospitable to one another without complaint." (How Christ continues to welcome us into His fellowship)
17. **1 John 3:23** - "This is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, just as He commanded us." (You cannot separate being in relationship with Christ with being in relationship with other humans)
18. **1 John 4:12** - "No one has seen God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us." (How people can still see Him)
